Medicare Fall Open Enrollment is October 15th through December 7th, 2025.

In the coming weeks many of you will receive notices from your current coverage companies, as well as solicitations for changing programs. On Monday, October 20, Hallie Devlin, SHINE Coordinator, will speak about what is involved in making changes to your Medicare Coverage and how to determine if making a change would be advantageous to your situation. Any changes you make will become effective January 1, 2025. At this presentation, Hallie will answer your general questions about Medicare Coverage and how to determine if making a change would be helpful to you.
